



#### **DEVELOPMENT ROAD PROJECT OUTLINE**

These are projects self-funded by the riders, organized by volunteer managers (appointed by CNZ) and supported by CNZ (Selection support, administration and planning support domestically, logistical support in Europe).

Current plans are for a May 2020 for Women Development Road project in Europe (Belgium, Switzerland and Germany) and possibly July-August 2020 for Men Development Road project (Exact location and dates TBC).
