Cycling New Zealand - Selection Regulations



Schedule 1 - Track World Championships 2023

1. Objectives

- 1.1 **Primary Objective:** To select athletes capable of winning medals in Olympic events at the 2023 UCI Track World Championships.
- 1.2 **Secondary Objective:** To support CNZ qualification strategies for the 2024 Olympic Games.
- 1.3 **Tertiary Objective:** To select athletes capable of winning medals in non-Olympic events at the 2023 Track World Championships.
- 1.4 **Performance Standards:** To determine whether an athlete meets the Primary or Tertiary Objectives in clauses 1.1 and 1.3, Selection Panels must consider athlete performances during the Performance Window in Table 1, with weight given to athletes consistently meeting those Performance Standards.

2. Considerations

2.1 General Selection Regulations: discipline selection panels must consider all relevant clauses in the CNZ General Selection Regulations.

Notification of Extenuating Circumstances is done by completing the form <u>HERE</u>.

- 2.2 **Discretionary Considerations:** Selection Panels may also consider any other information they deem relevant when considering the athletes performances during the Performance Window in Table 1, such as:
 - a. an athlete's ability to ride in support of a medal objective in more than one event;
 - b. an athlete's ability to enhance another athlete's medal success in competition;
 - c. developing the potential of an athlete for the 2024 Olympic Games or other Pinnacle Events;
 - the conditions in which results and performances were obtained, including but not limited to: the nature of the course, equipment used, environmental factors, team composition, and level of competition;
 - e. athlete performances outside of events listed in Table 1, including in competition, training, or trials;
 - f. the ability to train and compete with others in team Events (Team Pursuit, Team Sprint, and Madison);
 - g. the number and nature of Events in which an athlete may compete;
 - h. an athlete's attendance, and conduct at past competitions, training sessions, training camps, testing sessions, assessments, and other events; and
 - i. an athlete's performance behaviours, including active engagement in the IPP process, ambition, hunger, attention to detail, and ability to perform under pressure.

- 2.3 **Relevance & Weight:** Selection Panels have absolute discretion to determine the relevance and weight of these Considerations and any Extenuating Circumstances (see clause. 8 of General Selection Regulations).
- 2.4 **Logistics:** CNZ may book travel in advance of the Selection Date in order to take advantage of better rates. Bookings that require athlete names are placeholders only and do not constitute final selection.
