

Cycling New Zealand – Selection Regulations Schedule 2 – Road Teams – U19 World Championships and other U19 events 6 JANUARY 2023

- Objective: To provide age and stage appropriate international racing opportunities for development riders to prepare them for medal success in elite classes for future World Championships and Major Games.
- 2. Mandatory Eligibility Requirements for Athletes Seeking Selection: All athletes seeking selection to the Team must complete the Athlete Application process by providing all information requested in the online Rider Application Form by the date set out in clause 7 below.
- **3. Performance / Selection Time Period:** 10 months prior to the Selection Date as specified in clause 7 of this document.
- **4. Selection Process:** There is no obligation for the Relevant Selection Panel to fill the maximum number of positions specified by the UCI; pursuant to the UCI Road World Championships participation rules.

5. Weighting and-Considerations to the Final Junior Road Team Selection:

- 5.1. In considering the riders to be selected to the Road Team (road race and time trial) the Road Selection Panel must put more weight on any results and performances, which may or may not include ranking points, of a rider in the following competitions. The below mentioned events are listed in priority order:
 - i. UCI CN (National Championships) in Road Race and Time Trial;
 - ii. UCI CC (Continental Championships) in Road Race and Time Trial;
 - iii. UCI Sanctioned International events;
 - iv. Other International events;
 - v. National Road Series
- **5.2** Additionally, the relevant Selection Panel may, in its discretion, consider any one or more of the following factors in order to best achieve the overall objective set out in Clause 1 of this document:

- any of the result(s) and performance(s) of the rider at any national and/or international competitions, with priority given to results and performances in the 10-month period prior to the applicable team selection date;
- **b.** the views of the Cycling New Zealand coaches about the riders' ability to prepare for and perform in future events including priority events;
- **c.** the ability of the rider to train, compete and function with other riders in the team;
- **d.** the technical, physical, and mental skills, of the rider which are relevant to the nature of the event, the course and the environment of the applicable international competition;
- **e.** athletes attendance, attitude and conduct at past competitions, training sessions, assessments and other events;
- **f.** any other relevant matter that is reasonable to consider.

- **6.** If there is still quota available for selection after the consideration of clause 5.1 and 5.2 of this Selection Schedule, the High Performance Director and / or designate may in their sole discretion select one additional eligible rider per category to be added to the team.
- **7. Timeline:** Unless Cycling New Zealand decides otherwise, Road Teams will be selected and named at or before the dates mentioned below:
