

# **Cycling New Zealand - Selection Regulations**

Schedule 3C - Mountain Bike E-MTB Selection for 2024 UCI MTB (E-MTB) World Championships

Date of Issue: 18 April 2024

### 1. General Selection Regulation and this Schedule

- 1.1. This Schedule 3C is a schedule to the Cycling New Zealand General Selection Regulation (last updated 6 March 2024)(General Selection Regulation) for selection of the Mountain Bike E-MTB Team for the 2024 UCI MTB World Championships.
- 1.2. Both the General Selection Regulation and this Schedule apply, including that riders must be Eligible (as defined in the Regulation). Definitions used in the General Selection Regulation apply to this Schedule, unless stated otherwise. If there is any inconsistency between this Schedule and the General Selection Regulation, the General Selection Regulation will apply to the extent of any such inconsistency.

### 2. Selection Objective

2.1. Cycling New Zealand's objective in selecting a Mountain Bike Team for the 2024 UCI MTB World Championships is to select Eligible riders who will benefit from the opportunity of competing at international level to continue their development.

#### 3. Additional Requirements

- 3.1 All riders seeking selection to a Team must complete the Rider Application by providing all the information requested in the online Rider Application by the date set out in clause 5.
- 3.2 It is a condition of selection that riders must fund themselves to attend and compete at the 2024 UCI MTB World Championships and any competitions from which results or performances may be taken into account in considering their selection.

#### 4. Consideration to E-MTB Team Selection

- 4.1 Riders will be selected based on the following criteria:
  - a. As a minimum requirement, have demonstrated performance ability by competing in a UCI sanctioned MTB event / events at Cat 1 or above, in the two (2) years prior to the Team selection date.

 Selection will then be based on order of application. Allocation will be filled based on the order that completed applications are received, from eligible riders, until all New Zealand quota is fulfilled.

Reserve spots will be allocated to non-selected riders who achieve clause 4.1.a, in order that completed applications were received.

## 5. Key Timelines

The MTB Team will be selected in accordance with the Key Timelines set out below, unless Cycling New Zealand needs to change those dates for reasons outside of its control.
