

**Schedule 4 – BMX (Racing) – Elite, U23 and Junior (U19)**  
**Selection for 2024 UCI BMX (Racing) World Championships**  
**Date of Issue – 18 December 2023**

---

**1. General Selection Regulation and this Schedule**

- 1.1** This Schedule 4 is a schedule to the Cycling New Zealand General Selection Regulation (last updated 6 March 2024) ([General Selection Regulation](#)) for selection of the BMX Racing Teams for the Elite, U23 and Junior (U19) Teams for the 2024 UCI BMX (Racing) World Championships.
- 1.2** Both the General Selection Regulation and this Schedule apply, including that riders must be Eligible (as defined in the Regulation). Definitions used in the General Selection Regulation apply to this Schedule, unless stated otherwise. If there is any inconsistency between this Schedule and the General Selection Regulation, the General Selection Regulation will apply to the extent of any such inconsistency.

**2. Selection Objectives**

- 2.1** Cycling New Zealand’s objectives in selecting a BMX (Racing) Team for the 2024 UCI BMX (Racing) World Championships differ between Elite / U23 riders and Junior riders as set out in this clause. In considering riders for selection, the Selection Panel will select Eligible riders it considers:

**2.1.1 Selection Objectives for Men and Women Elite and U23:**

- a. will benefit from the opportunity of competing at international level to continue their development, and to show their capability for potential selection for the 2024 Olympic Games, and/or:
- b. are capable of winning medals at the 2024 UCI BMX (Racing) World Championships.

**2.1.2 Selection Objectives for Junior Men and Women:**

- a. show potential for medal success in elite classes at future World Championships and Olympic Games.

### **3. Additional Eligibility Requirements**

**3.1** All riders seeking selection to a Team must complete the Rider Application by providing all the information requested in the online Rider Application Form by the date set out in clause 8 below.

**3.2** In addition to the Eligibility requirements in the General Selection Regulation, all riders wishing to be considered for selection must participate in the 2024 BMX New Zealand National Championships in Hawke's Bay from 15<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup> March 2024, unless non-participation is agreed in writing with the High Performance Director (HPD) or designate. Non-participation is to be applied for prior to the start of competition of the 2024 National Championships by completing the Event Exemption Form [HERE](#).

### **4 Additional Requirement**

**4.1** Selected riders will be required to fund their attendance at the 2024 UCI BMX(Racing) World Championships.

### **5 Selection Criteria for Elite Riders – Men and Women**

**5.1** In considering which Eligible Elite riders satisfy the Selection Objectives (in clause 2.1.1):

**5.1.1** Primary Selection Criteria: The Selection Panel must select any female riders and any male riders who achieve a start in the Elite final at the 2023 BMX (Racing) World Championships or an Elite final at a UCI BMX Racing World Cup within the Performance Window, subject to available quota places at the 2024 UCI BMX (Racing) World Championships.

**5.1.2** Secondary Selection Criteria: If:

- a. there are more riders entitled to selection under the Primary Selection Criteria than there are available quota places; or
- b. a rider does not meet the Primary Selection Criteria for automatic selection:  
  
the Selection Panel will consider riders for selection, for the number of quota places available, in order of their ranking based on the allocation of points from riders' results in BMX Racing Events in the following International Competitions:

<b>UCI BMX World Cup Round 1 – Rotorua</b> , (10 February 2024)
<b>UCI BMX World Cup Round 2 – Rotorua</b> , (11 February 2024)
<b>2024 Oceania Continental Championships – Brisbane</b> (18 February 2024)
<b>UCI BMX World Cup Round 3– Brisbane</b> (24 February 2024)
<b>UCI BMX World Cup Round 4 – Brisbane</b> (25 February 2024)

## 6. Selection Criteria for U23 Riders – Men and Women

**6.1** In considering which Eligible U23 riders satisfy the Selection Objectives (in clause 2.1.1):

**6.1.1 Primary Selection Criteria:** The Selection Panel must select any female riders and any male riders who achieve a start in the U23 final at the 2023 UCI BMX (Racing) World Championships or a start in a U23 final at a UCI BMX Racing World Cup in the Performance Window, subject to available quota places at the 2024 UCI BMX Racing World Championships.

**6.1.2 Secondary Selection:** If:

- a. there are more riders entitled to selection under the Primary Selection than there are available national quota places; or
  - b. a rider does not meet the Primary Selection criteria for automatic selection;
- the Selection Panel will consider riders for selection, for the number of quota places available, in order of their ranking based on the allocation of points from riders' results in BMX Racing Events in the following International Competitions:

<b>UCI BMX World Cup Round 1 – Rotorua</b> , (10 February 2024)
<b>UCI BMX World Cup Round 2 – Rotorua</b> , (11 February 2024)
<b>2024 Oceania Continental Championships – Brisbane</b> (18 February 2024)
<b>UCI BMX World Cup Round 3– Brisbane</b> (24 February 2024)
<b>UCI BMX World Cup Round 4 – Brisbane</b> (25 February 2024)

## 7. Selection Criteria for Junior (U19) Riders – Men and Women

**7.1** In considering which Eligible Junior (U19) riders satisfy the Selection Objectives (in clause 2.1.2):

**7.1.1** Primary Selection Criteria: The Selection Panel must select any female riders and any male riders who achieve a medal (top 3) in the Junior Men or Junior Women category at the 2024 Oceania BMX Championships, subject to available quota places at the 2024 UCI BMX Racing World Championships.

**7.1.2** Secondary Selection Criteria: If:

- a. there are more riders entitled to selection under the Primary Selection Criteria than there are available quota places; or
- b. a rider does not meet the Primary Selection Criteria for automatic selection; the Selection Panel will consider riders for selection, for the number of quota places available, in order of their ranking based on the accumulation of points earned for results in the Junior / U19 Selection Competitions listed below. No competition shall be accorded any more weight than the other. Points will be awarded according to the table in 7.2. In case of a tie, the rider with the better result at 2024 BMX Oceania Championship will be ranked higher.

## 7.2 Points System – Juniors

<b>1<sup>st</sup> Place</b>	10 points	<b>5<sup>th</sup> Place</b>	4 points
<b>2<sup>nd</sup> Place</b>	8 points	<b>6<sup>th</sup> Place</b>	3 points
<b>3<sup>rd</sup> Place</b>	6 points	<b>7<sup>th</sup> Place</b>	2 points
<b>4<sup>th</sup> Place</b>	5 points	<b>8<sup>th</sup> Place</b>	1 point

## 8. Key Timelines:

The BMX Racing Teams will be selected in accordance with the Key Timelines set out below, unless Cycling New Zealand is required to change those dates for reasons outside of its control.
