



2025 UCI Cycling Esports World Championships New Zealand Qualifying Event Information

GENERAL INFORMATION

NZBRO, on behalf of Cycling New Zealand will host a single qualifying race on **Friday 22 August, 7pm NZST**.

New Zealand has been allocated a total of twelve (12) entries for the 2025 UCI Cycling Esports World Championship Semi-Final. The allocation of this quota will be given to the top five (5) men and top seven (7) women, at the conclusion of the qualification race.

Test Races

NZBRO will hold test races on the following days (all rides will take place at 7:00pm):

- Wednesday 23 July
- Friday 25 July
- Wednesday 30 July
- Friday 1 August
- Friday 8 August
- Friday 15 August – this will be a practice race on the Qualifying Course

The above races are open events, so entry is by selecting the ride on the MyWhoosh platform.

Qualification Event

- Friday 22 August, 7:00pm

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

All riders seeking entry into the Cycling New Zealand Cycling Esports Team must complete the Rider Application by providing all information requested in the online form by **24 August 2025**.

Riders allocated an entry for the Semi-Final must hold a current UCI Race Licence with the nationality marked NZL. This licence can be purchased following allocation of entry to the Semi-Final.

Riders are responsible for having their own smart trainer, which must meet all MyWhoosh requirements.
