Schedule 8 - Zwift World Championships

1. Introduction

- 1.1. The Esports World Championships are also known as the Zwift World Championships
- 1.2. New Zealand has been allocated the following quotas by the UCI:

Men: 1 place

Women: 3 places

There is no obligation on the Relevant Selection Panel to fill the maximum number of positions specified by the UCI; pursuant to the UCI Zwift World Championships participation rules.

- 1.3. This document outlines the selection regulations for these quota spots.
- 1.4. For the purposes of this Selection Schedule, the selection panel will consist of:

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 Must have a valid licence with the UCI ID code from the national federation of your residence, in accordance with the UCI Regulations.
- 2.2 Anti-Doping Compliance:

In order to be eligible all riders must be in either the

- a) UCI Registered Testing Pool; or
- b) A national registered testing pool or another national testing pool; or
- c) For the women's category, also riders contracted to a UCI Women World Tour Team in 2020.

Note: The anti-doping eligibility criteria is deemed fulfilled for athletes included in a RTP of another International Federation, signatory of the World Anti-Doping Code.

2.3. Zwift Experience:

- a) Athletes must be registered on Zwift power and have progressed to at least level 5* in the game at the time that they are selected.
- b) Preferably athletes will have also taken part in one of Zwift's major broadcast events.

3. Selection Process

- 3.1 Eligible riders will be invited to apply to be considered for selection by the due date as per Paragraph 5.
- 3.2 By selecting the riders having the highest Zwift Power worldwide rankings to the lowest, will be followed through until all UCI quota spots have been allocated.
- 3.3 The selection panel reserve the right to exercise discretion in selection athletes for this event.

4. Financial Conditions

4.1. Participation at the UCI Zwift World Championship, is dependent on selected athletes being able to fund themselves.

^{*} Level 5 requires a Zwift User to have ridden on the platform and gained a total of 4,000 XP (Experience Points). This equates to roughly 200km. A Zwift user's level can be seen on their profile via the Zwift Companion App when searching for a user, or in-game by the user themselves at the top of the HUD (Heads Up Display).
