Partnership agreement – EC had discussion with Chris Christensen last week to review the partnership agreement – initial starting point was what was presented back in September

2022. Following the discussion with Chris – an updated version will be sent to EC for circulation to the Council. Areas for follow up include membership, events/calendar responsibility. As a council we need to determine what we want. NB partnership agreement is until 2024 and under the current financial constraints of CNZ

Events – There is a current no central location for a calendar of events in NZ. A central location to manage sanctioned events and record other events so organizers can schedule events at times to reduce any clashes competing events. There is a current lack of information, and a spot is needed where we can go to get information. This should help with planning for both Local, national, and international events.

New CNZ CEO – Simon Peterson – EC had Zoom Call with SP covering an update on where things are at from a RTX perspective. SP asked if there was one thing RTX wanted – what would it be? SP can look to source funding for a specific project. EC passed on RC's contact details for the CX perspective. SP reiterated that the funds held by CNZ are all ringfenced for the HP Programme, and there is currently no cash sponsorship for CNZ, however there are various contra sponsorship deals.
