### Road Races 17<sup>th</sup> / 18<sup>th</sup> April Race Information

#### Sign On

Riders are reminded to sign on as early as possible for all Road Races. Sign On will be in the Skoda Tent outside the hall. Sign in closes 10 minutes prior to race start.

#### Roll Out (Junior Grades)

All Juniors must roll out prior to the race, as early as possible. Roll Out will be conducted outside the hall. Bikes do not need to remain at the start after checks have been conducted. The first five finishers must be re-checked immediately after the race, again outside the hall. **Placings will not be confirmed until rollout re-check has been completed.** Other random riders may also be selected for rollout re-check

#### Race Neutralisation

Races that are turning right at the end of Mangatete Road to head to the finish line will be given priority over races that are just starting. In order to allow the finishing race to turn right safely, the starting race may be neutralised for a short time during the first 6km, in addition to the normal neutralisation period from the start line. The lead car will deploy the red flag to indicate neutralisation or you may be stopped by traffic management staff.

#### Wheels for Neutral Service

Wheels for neutral service must be dropped to the "officials parking" area (marked with a green Skoda flag) just beyond the driveway of the car-park. Please label your wheels with your age group and race number and drop your wheels no later than 20 minutes prior to your start.

## **Litter**

A reminder that NO litter (including gel packs) is to be dropped anywhere on the race circuit, other than in the designated litter zone on Mangatete Road. The start and finish of the litter zone will be signposted.

## **Hazards**

- The roads are narrow, and oversize farm machinery and large trucks will be on the roads throughout the day. There will also be bunches travelling in both directions on parts of the circuit. **It is extremely important that riders keep to the left of the centre line at all times.**
- There is a short section of unsealed road, at the corner of Nicholson Road and Poutakataka Road. This is approximately 16 km after the start of the race. The surface is good, but care should be taken while turning left into Poutakataka Road.

## **Masters “Wave Starts**

- Women Master 3 & 4 (WM3 starting 11.55am)  
These groups will start at 2 minute intervals
- Women Masters 5 - 8 (WM5 starting 12.05pm)  
These groups will start at 2 minute intervals
- Men Masters 7 – 9 (MM7 starting 1.15pm)  
These groups will start at 3 minute intervals
