Entry Eligibility & Criteria

1. Events

- Time Trial
- Road Race

2. Eligibility

- All championship riders must represent their club and entries will be required to be approved by the representing club.
- The event is open to New Zealand and Australian riders.
- “New Zealand riders” now includes permanent New Zealand Residents who are financial members of a NZ Club & Centre.
- Place getters, regardless of nationality, shall receive relevant medals.
- The first placed New Zealander shall be acknowledged as the Champion for the event

3. Age Groups

- Ages are calculated as at 31 December 2022. The minimum age is 13 as at 31 December 2022.
- The following Age groups are available for Boys/Girls Men/Women.

Under 17: 15-16 years

Under 19: 17-18 years

Under 23: 19-22 years

Senior: 23-34 years

Master 1: 35-39 years

Master 2: 40-44 years

Master 3: 45-49 years

Master 6: 60-64 years

Master 7: 65-69 years

Master 8: 70-74 years

Master 9: 75-79 years

4. Licensing

- A 2022 Cycling New Zealand Youth/Adult or schools licence is required prior to entry for all championship events (Youth Licence is available for those grades up to and including U19).
- All Australian riders must have a current 2022 Cycling Australia domestic license and appropriate travel insurance to cover riding and racing while in New Zealand. Riders must be prepared to provide proof of insurance if required.
- Team Managers and Officials are required to hold a 2022 Adult Licence with the appropriate technical endorsement from your centre.

5. Teams

- The event is **club representation** only. Entries from New Zealand/UCI Registered Trade Team are not accepted.
