- Any late changes in writing to Commissaire's Secretary. Change sheets on back of Tech Guide or collect from Race Desk.

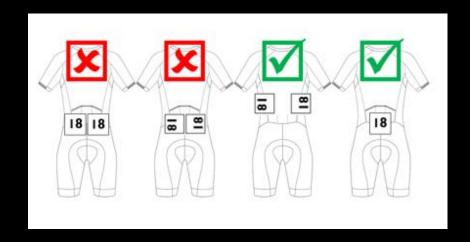


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- Madison pairings

- Track Access and Hours
- The infield is accessible from 8.00am each morning
- Track open for warm up 1 hour before each session starts
- Warm up is only for those riders competing in the upcoming session





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- Track Flow
- Bike Check and Roll out Procedure
- Anti Doping
- May be present. Ensure you have Photo ID available at all times. Anti doping rooms are on Level 1, follow signs to access.
- Medals Presentations
- Your own responsibility to get to podium
- Race kit must be worn

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• U17 races:

Double tempo

- Sprint every second lap, 1 pt awarded to the winner across the line
- 20 laps, 4 non-scoring, then sprint laps 16, 14, 12.... (i.e. bell 17, 15, 13...)

Snowball points

- 12 laps each lap worth points increasing in value from 1 on the first lap to 12 on the final lap
- Only the winner across the line is awarded points, apart from the final lap, where 2nd is awarded 2 pt and 3rd is awarded 1 pt.
- Tie break procedure: highest position in final sprint
