

## Cycling New Zealand Selection Regulations

Schedule 4 – BMX Teams (BMX Racing and BMX Freestyle)

16 October 2018

### BMX – Racing

---

- 1. Athlete Nomination:** All athletes seeking selection in BMX Racing Teams must complete the Athlete Nomination process by completing all information on the on-line Rider Application Form as prescribed by Cycling New Zealand.
- 2. Competitions:** Unless Cycling New Zealand decides otherwise, a BMX Racing Team will be selected (by the Selection Dates) to attend the following International BMX Competition:

2019 World BMX Championship, Zolder, Belgium 23-28 July 2019	Junior - Men and Women Senior or Elite - Men and Women	23-28 July 2019	Selections announced no later than 17 May 2019

- 3. No Selecting Squads:** For the following competitions, Cycling New Zealand will not select a squad or team. However, riders who have a valid licence issued by Cycling New Zealand for 2019, may enter these events individually:
  - Oceania Continental Championships (CC) to be held in Te Awamutu, 19 January 2019
  - 2019 Supercross, Round 1, Manchester, Great Britain; 27 April 2019
  - 2019 Supercross, Round 2, Manchester, Great Britain; 28 April 2019
  - 2019 Supercross, Round 3, Papendal, The Netherlands; 11 May 2019
  - 2019 Supercross, Round 4, Papendal, The Netherlands; 12 May 2019
  - 2019 Supercross, Round 5, Paris, France; 8 June 2019
  - 2019 Supercross, Round 6, Paris, France; 9 June 2019
  - 2019 Supercross, Round 7, Rock Hill, USA; 14 September 2019
  - 2019 Supercross, Round 8, Rock Hill, USA; 15 September 2019
  - 2019 Supercross, Round 9, Santiago del Estero, Argentina; 28 September 2019
  - 2019 Supercross, Round 10, Santiago del Estero, Argentina; 29 September 2019

**4. Weighting:** The relevant Selection Panel will put more weight on any results and performances of a rider in the following events in the 12 month period prior to the Selection Date), which may or may not include ranking points. These below mentioned events are listed in priority order:

- for Men's Elite and Women's Elite;
  - i. UCI CDM (Supercross World Cup) results and performances;
  - ii. UCI C1, HC and CC event results and performances;
  - iii. UCI CN\* (BMXNZ Elite Nationals) results and performances;
  - iv. Championship 8M Event – Feb 2019 one off event results and performances;
  
- for Men's Juniors and Women's Juniors;
  - i. UCI C1 and CC event results and performances.
  - ii. UCI CN\* event (BMXNZ Elite Nationals) results and performances;
  - iii. BMX NZ World Championship Junior Elite Qualifier (WCJEQ) results and performances;

*\* National championship (CN) participation is mandatory for eventual selection to World Championship Team (unless agreed in writing by the convenor of the selection panel)*

**Weighting Note 1:** Results used for selection purposes must be of Quarter finals or above at Supercross events. For C1, CC & CN or other non-UCI qualifiers must be top 8 placing. Lesser or moto results will not be considered.

**Weighting Note 2:** BMXNZ WCJEQ events are weighted in the following order;

- i. AUS Series Round 2, 23-24 February 2019 (dates and location to be confirmed by BMXA)
- ii. Championship 8M Event – Feb 2019 one off event results and performances;

**Weighting Note 3:** Supercross event results for Juniors will be considered as part of the selection criteria if the results meet the levels as specified in Weighting Note 1.

## BMX – Freestyle

---

- 1. Athlete Nomination:** All athletes seeking selection in BMX – Freestyle Teams must complete the Athlete Nomination process by completing all information on the on-line Rider Application Form as prescribed by Cycling New Zealand.
- 2. Competitions:** Unless Cycling New Zealand decides otherwise, a BMX – Freestyle Team will be selected (by the Selection Dates) to attend the UCI Urban World Championships:

2018 Urban World Championships, Chengdu, China 7-11 November 2018	Elite**	5-11 November, 2018	No later than 19 October 2018

\*\* Note: age group for Elites starts at age 15.

- Weighting:** The relevant Selection Panel will put more weight on any results and performances of a rider in the following events in the 12 month period prior to the Selection Date, which may or may not include ranking points. The below mentioned events are listed in priority order:
  - for Men's Elite and Women's Elite (Age 15 and over);
    - UCI CDM (World Cup) results and performances;
    - UCI C1 event results and performances;
    - UCI CN (Nationals) results and performances;

**Weighting Note 1:** Only results equal or better than what is mentioned in Table 2. will be used for selection purposes.
